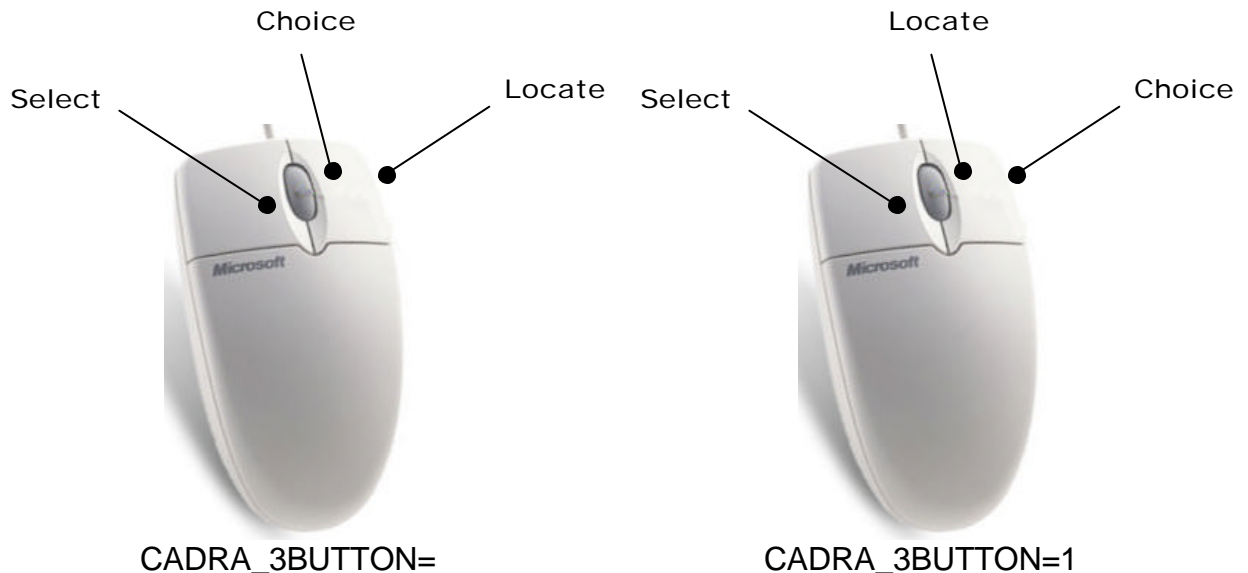


Dealing With Windows Mouse Problems

A simple modification to the setting CADRA_3BUTTON your cadra.ini file lets you establish an arrangement that you are most productive with. The table below shows the options and the appropriate setting for your cadra.ini file.



If the right or middle mouse buttons are not functioning, try this simple technique to get up and running again:

1. From the Windows Start menu, select Settings entry then Control Panel.
2. In the Control Panel dialog, double click on the Mouse icon. Note that this icon could appear differently based on the vendor and type of mouse installed on your system.
3. Select the Buttons Tab
4. Make sure the mouse buttons are defined in a left to right manner.
 - Left Button set to Click/Select
 - Middle Button set to Middle Button
 - Right Button set to Context Menu/Alternate select

Note: If you have a 3-button mouse you must install the proper 3-button mouse driver for that input device. If you use the 2-button mouse driver, it will not be possible to properly configure the mouse as described above.
