



## Installing FLM on NT

Note: Cadra Software and License file should already be installed.

Open up a Command prompt

Key in:

**flmservc <path to Cadra directory> flmservc.exe**

EXAMPLE:

Flmservc install c:\cadra\flmservc.exe

You will now see the below information on the screen.

FLM service created.

FLM service start pending

FLM service started

Note: If you get an error message 1067 this is a license issue. Please check your NLS.TXT file located in your Cadra directory. Make sure that the first line reads .primary your server name This MUST be in lowercase letters and the space in between .primary your server name MUST be spaces NOT a tab.

## Starting, Stopping and Removing - FLM License Manager on NT

Select the START button

Select SETTINGS

Select CONTROL PANEL

Select SYSTEM

Select FLM License Manager from the List

Select the Start or Stop button.

The second option is to open up a Command prompt:

Change directories to the directory were Cadra is installed.

To Stop the service:

Key in: **flmservc stop**

To Start the service:

Key in: **flmservc start**

To Remove the service:

Key in: **flmservc remove**

Note: the only way to remove the FLM License Manager is using the command prompt.
