

Trouble Installing AMT Products on Foreign Language UNIX Platforms

ISSUE

When installing AMT products on a foreign language UNIX platform, you get the following message (or something similar to it) during the installation process:

Insufficient space exists on the disk partition for /usr/amt to install software.

MORE INFORMATION

The reason why this problem occurs is because the installation script works differently on a foreign language platform than it does on an English platform. More specifically, when checking for disk space, the **df** command looks at a different column to do its free disk space check on a foreign language platform than it does on an English platform.

RESOLUTION

To avoid this issue, take the following steps:

1. In properties, set the environment variable to US or English.
2. Open up a new command tool.
3. Start the installation for the AMT product again.

Once the installation is complete, you may reset the environment variable back to the foreign language platform you were using before.
