## **Tech-Tip – Using Windows Logins Effectively**

Every user is different. Rarely will you find two or more users who agree 100% of the time on which icons should go in which toolbar or what short keys should do what.

If you have to share a Prospector system with another user (or several other users), it can be a good idea to make sure each user gets their own separate login. This allows you and every other user to setup your own unique Prospector environment.

Prospector remembers customized toolbars, strokes, shortcut keys, N/C Program Tree and many other settings on a per-user basis. With your own login, your customizations will not disturb any other user login. When you login to the system and start Prospector, your toolbars, short keys, strokes, ... are automatically put into effect.

Don't forget that you can still exchange settings with other users by using the Export Settings dialog under the Tools pull-down menu. This is a nice feature if you want to setup a new user or a new system without going through the manual steps of recreating your unique custom Prospector environment.
