



## Done Building Event

- Prospector 5.0 and above

### **SUMMARY**

You can setup Prospector so that when it has finished generating and verifying programs it will send out a notification. This can be useful if a user minimizes Prospector in order to carry out other actions on the computer, but wants to know when Prospector is done building.

### **MORE INFORMATION**

Follow these steps to setup Prospector so that when it has finished building it will send out a notification message.

1. Download the **BuildFinish.pvb** macro file that is associated with this tip.
2. Load up Prospector, and click on **Tools -> Customize**
3. Click on the **Macro Files** tab
4. Click on the **Add** button
5. Find and select the macro file you downloaded in step 1.
6. Click **Open** to add the macro file to the **Macro Files** list
7. Check the **BuildFinish.pvb** macro file in the **Macro Files** list to enable it
8. Click **OK** to close the **Customize** dialog.

Now, when Prospector finishes building its programs, the following message will be sent in a message box, "**Prospector has finished building all programs.**"

Once the macro file has been loaded by following the steps above, you can enable/disable this feature by doing the following:

1. In Prospector, click on **Tools -> Customize**
2. Click on the **Macro Files** tab
3. Uncheck the **BuildFinish.pvb** file to disable it, or check it to enable it again
